Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Anne J^es Drew, my Mule Rhoda, one Cow & Calf,
Six head of my Sheep, and two fifths of all
the crop now growing, after the rent is paid,
Two Beds Bedsteads and furniture, all my
Cooking utensils, Chairs, Knives and Forks
and half of my Drockery -

Item 3rd I desire at my death that Henry
Hamilton my Son in law take three of my boys
to raise, to wit, Cyrus, William and Miles -
And that my Son in law Matthew Pitts take
two of my Sons, David and John and my
daughter Martha to raise -

Item 4th I desire all my property except
what I have given to my beloved wife Anne
Drew, be sold this fall this fall at public
out Cry, and the proceeds equally divided
between Henry Hamilton, Matthew Pitts,
Cyrus, David, John, Martha, William
Miles and Augustus. Share and Share
alike; I have given little Pitts and
Dolly Hamilton each one Cow & Calf worth
fifteen dollars each. I desire that all the
other Children named in this will each to
have fifteen dollars out of the proceeds of
my estate before the division is made, then
all to share alike -

Item 5th Having early confidence in
the honesty, integrity and Christian piety
of William Nix of Said County, I appoint
and hereby constitute him my Sole Executor
to carry out this my last will and testament
