and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life
do therefore ordain make and publish this to be my last will and
testament That is to say first after all my lawful and just debts
are paid and discharged the residue of my estate both real and
personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows to wit to my beloved
wife Mary the same and appurtenances therein contained to her
four parts in the thirteenth district and one fourth portion to her
together with all my personal property that I may be possessed in
it at my death and any money that may be received if any of my
debts be paid and my wife Mary has at any time disposed of
any personal property that is of the debt which she thinks necessary
for her support and comfort and after her death to be sold and
equally divided among my lawful heirs.

I therefore make constitute and appoint George W. Cochran my son
to be my executor of this my last will and testament and if the
said George W. Cochran should be out of the way or refuse to do so
I appoint Daniel McWhorter to carry out this my last testament
On witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed
my seal this 28th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and sixty eight Thomas Cochran
