That I will direct all of my just debts to be paid and in order to do so I want my own due to sell off such property as best they may think can be spared from the use of my wife and her children and that it be done as soon as possible not to conflict with the value or real worth of the property to be disposed of for the accomplishment of this object

Item I do desire the remaining property to be kept together for the mutual benefit of my wife and child or children as the case may be

Item I do now ordain and appoint my wife Henrietta Frances Rhinheart and A. W. Rhinheart executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have caused my hand and seal to be affixed this November 23 1852

Sarah Christiane Hance Cynthia Melissa Hance and Martha Mearns
Hance each one her husband and permit me to make them equal with the
rest of my children that live by me

Item I do desire the balance of my property not consisting of one lot of
land in the 13 district and 3rd section of Whitfield County heres to come
I hope to be a good farming tract to be run with such household
when furnished as my wife may see fit to keep and she proceeds after
paying my debts to be equally divided between my children to wit

I do give to her and her heirs and assigns all my property not divided with the
other children for good and lawfully acquired or to be acquired

Item I do direct my wife or in case of her decease it is my desire
that she live and occupy my house and my plantation heres to come
until she begins to want except my share of the land of my wife at her
and her heirs and assigns may see fit to substitute and if she
free from the disposition of her present or future land

Item I do desire that my wife and single children remain in my old
land in Chattooga County and that she be allowed to occupy and the pro-
ceeds of the same until it is my desire that any of the land be
sold or leased to her. I do hereby give to her the life interest of my said
wife

Item I do hereby appoint and constitute you my executor and you are to
do according to the my last will and testament in the 11 day of Sept
1863

Item 2nd I desire and desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my executors hereinafter appointed

Item 3rd I give to my wife Hannah Howell during her natural life or widowhood the following lots of land (to wit) No 218, 219, 221 all in the sixth district and fourth section of said County together with one horse one cow & carriage two sows and five seven hens of sheep such as she may choose also such house hold and kitchen furniture as she may wish out with

Item 4th I give to my four single daughters to wit Mary Catherine Hannah Sarah Caroline Hannah Cynthia Rebecca Howell and Martha Moscovitz Howell each one her husband and jointure to make them equal with the rest of my children that live long

Item 5th I desire the balance of my property not consisting of one lot of land in the 13 district and 3rd section of Whitfield County heretofore been sheep and hog raising lots to be sold with such household and kitchen furniture as my wife may wish to keep and the proceeds after paying my debts to be equally divided between my children to wit the sons to wit John A Howell Thomas G Howell Elizabeth A Howell Maria Ann Howell John Taylor Olga Ann Ann Ann Mary A Howell Sarah Caroline Anne Caroline Rebecca Howell Martha Moscovitz Howell except leaving your wife a life annuity and the interest on my property as you shall think fit the children may in their discretion sell or dispose of the same as they shall think fit

Item 6th I do hereby give or in case of my intestacy it is my desire that the best and most profitable use of my property be made by my executors or their heirs and assigns except my daughter Rebecca Howell who I do give and bequeath to her and her heirs and assigns her share of the proceeds from the disposition of the present and future land

Item 7th It is my desire that my wife and my children remain in my said lands in Chattooga County and that she be entitled to one year and the proceeds of the same and that it is my desire that one of the land be sold or let to the best advantage and that my wife and children be paid my wife

Item 8th I do hereby appoint and constitute you my executors and you are to have the custody of my said lands and the proceeds thereof until the 11 day of Sept 1863
