The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Lewis A. Green & Wm. Lynch have this day appointed Guardians to Elizabeth Martin Bagby Thomas Bagby Martin Bagby Alfred Bagby Minors of the M. Bagby deceased

Now if the said John R. Bagby and Wm. Lynch do well and truly demean themselves as guardians as aforesaid according to the best of Guardianship having even due heed and according to law in such case made & provided then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
