these presents that we Abner P  
Lowely principals and Thomas M Johnston  
& Edward Townsend are held and firmly

bound unto the Justices of the Inferior Court when  
sitting for Ordinary purposes for said County and their  
Successors in office in the just and full sum of  
Three Thousand Dollars for the payment of which sum  
we bind our selves our heirs executors and administrators  
Jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with  
our seals and date this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847

The condition of the above bond  
is such of the above bound Abner P. Lowely administrator  
of the goods Chattels and Credits of Barton Lowely late of  
said County deceased do make a true and perfect inventory  
of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said  
deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession  
or knowledge of the said Abner P. Lowely or into the hands  
or possession of any other person or persons for him;  
and the same so made do exhibit to the said Court of  
Ordinary when he shall be hereunto required and such  
goods Chattels & Credits do well and truly administer  
according to law and do make a just and true account  
of his actings and doings shew and when required by the  
Superior Court or Judge of Probate for the County and  
all the rest of the goods Chattels and Credits which shall  
be found remaining upon the account of the said administrator  
the same being first allowed by said Court shall deliver and  
pay to such persons respectively as are entitled to the same  
by law and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and  
Testament was made by the said deceased and the same be  
proved before the Court and the executor obtained a certificate  
of the Probate thereof and the said Abner Lowely do in such  
case if required render up and deliver the said letters of administration  
then this bond to be void else to remain in full force
