Ambros Manning Solomon Manning George
W Cook, & John R Galt are held and firmly
bound unto the honorable the Justices of

the Inferior Court of said County. sitting for Ordinary purposes
and their successors in office in the sum and full sum of Three
thousand Dollars, for the true payment of which sum the said
Justices as aforesaid and their successors we bind ourselves our
heirs executors, and administrators in the whole and for the whole
sum jointly severally and jointly by these presents sealed with our
Seals and dated this 12th day of March Eighteen hundred and forty nine

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that
if the above bound Ambros Manning and Solomon Manning
Administrators of the Estate real and personal of Benjamin
Manning late of this County deceased, do make a true and
perfect inventory of all the Estate both real and personal
of said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession
or knowledge of said administrators, or unto the hands or possession
of any person or persons for them and the same do make do
Exhibit unto the said Court of Ordinary when they shall be thereto
required and such Estate do well and truly administer according
to law, and do make a just and true account of their doings
and things therein when they shall be thereto required by the
Court of Ordinary for said County and all the rest of the said
Estate which shall be found remaining upon the account of the
said administration the same being first allowed by the court
shall deliver and pay to such person or persons as lawfully are
entitled to the same by law and if it shall hereafter appear
that any last will and Testament was made by the deceased and
the same be proved by the court and the Executors obtain a certificate
of the probate thereof and the said administrators do in each case if
required render and deliver up the said Estates of administration
then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force
