

R. I. Corvart, admr. of Georgia Cherokee County
Bond

Know all men by these presents that we Robert I. Corvart & George I. Hoyle are held and firmly bound unto the Honorable Justices of the Inferior Court of said county sitting for Ordinary purposes and their successors in office, in the Inst and full sum of one Hundred and Twenty Dollars for the payment of which sum to the Justices as aforesaid, and their successors we bind ourselves our heirs, executors, or administrators in the whole and for the whole sum jointly and severally and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 2^d Sept. 1850.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Robert I. Corvart, Administrator of the Estate real and personal of Eli Anderson, late of said county, do make a true and perfect inventory of all the Estate both real and personal of said deceased, which have or shall come into the hands possession or knowledge of the said R. I. Corvart or into the hands possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made be exhibited to the said Court of Ordinary which he shall be therein required and such estate do well and truly administer according to law, and do make a just and true account of his doings and doings thence when by the said R. I. Corvart shall be therein required by the Court of Ordinary for said county, and all the rest of said estate which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration the same being first allowed by the Court shall deliver and pay to such person or persons as are intitled to the same by law and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the deceased and the same be proved before the Court, and the executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said R. I. Corvart do in such case if required under and deliver up the said letters of administration, then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force
