and their successors our bind ourselves our heirs executors
& administrators in the whole and for the whole sum
Jointly and severally and firmly by these presents sealed
with our seals and dated this 2^d Sept. 1850.

The condition of the above allegation is
such that if the above bound Robert J. Covast, Administrator
of the Estate real and personal of Eli Anderson, late
of said County, do or do make a true and perfect inventory
of all the Estates both real and personal of
said deceased which have or shall come into the
hands possession or knowledge of the said P. C. Covast
or into the hands possession of any other person or
persons for him and the same so made as aforesaid
to the said court of Ordinary where he shall
be summoned required and such estates as well and
truly administer according to law and do make a
just and true account of his actions and
doings there when as the said R. Covast shall
be summoned required by the court of Ordinary
for said County and all the rest of said estates
whereas shall be found remaining upon the
account of the said administration the same being
first allowed by the court shall divide and pay
to such person or persons as are intitled to the
same by law and if it shall hereafter appear that any
last will and testament was made by the deceased
and the same be proved before the court and the said
R. Covast do in such case if required render and
divide up the said letters of administration, this
this allegation to be void she to remain in full force
