presents, Seals with our seals and dated this 13th
day of January 1854.

The condition of the above obligations

make a true and perfect inventory of the Estate
both Real and personal of said deceased which
shall or has come into the hands possession or
knowledge of the said Joel L. Gatt or in to the
hands possession of any person or persons for
him and the same so made do exhibit to the
said Court of Ordinary when (called on) he shall
be thereto required and such estate do well and
truly administer according to law and do make a
true and just account of all his actings
and doings therein when he the said Joel
L. Gatt shall be thereto required by the
Court of Ordinary for said County and all
the rest of the said estate which shall be
found remaining upon the account of the ad-
ministrator the same being first allowed by the said
