day been appointed by the honorable the Court of Ordinary
for said County for administration of their estate now with the
said amount of the goods Chattels & credits of John M. Cope
deceased. Sure if the said Jas. & Ruth do make or cause to
be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular
the goods Chattels & credits of said estate and what have
or may come to the hands and possession of the said
Jas. & Ruth or other persons for him and the same to
make do exhibit to the Court of ordinary for said County
at such time as he shall be required by the said
Court of Ordinary and the same goods Chattels and
credits do well and truly administer according to
law and make a just and true account of his acts
& doings when by law required; and further do we
and truly pray and desire all the legacies contained
and specified in the said will as far as the said goods
Chattels and credits of said estate will extend or doo require
then this obligation to be void else wherein in full force
