of the said Elizabeth Brooke or unto the hands or possession of any other person or persons
for him; and the same be made as Exhibit to the said Court of Ordinary when she shall
be thereto required, & such Estate as well & truly administer according to law and do
make a just and true account of her actions and doings therein when she shall be thereto
required, by the Court of Ordinary for said County and all the rest of the said
Estate which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration the
same being first allowed by the Court, then to pay to such person or persons
respecting the same as the same may appear to be due to the effect that any
sum or sums paid by the said deceased to any person or persons before the
date of his death shall be deducted therefrom and the same be paid over before the
date of his death to the extent of his debts and expenses of administration
