Cherokee County by these presents
that we James M. Coy Jr. and Daniel
H. Bond John Martin Secuties are held
and firmly bound unto the honorable

James Jordan ordinary of said County and his successors
office in the sum of Ten thousand Dollars to the true payment
of which well and truly to be made as hereinafter directed making
execution and administration of us and each of us jointly by
these presents voluntarily with our hands and seals this 5th
day of September 1852

The condition of the above obligation is
such that whereas the above bound James M. Coy Jr. has this
day appeared to the honorable James Jordan ordinary for the
County of Cherokee and State of Georgia for and has obtained
Temporary title of administration of the goods chattels
rights and credits of John J. Coyle deceased now of the above
bound James M. Coy Jr. shall lawfully collect and receive
from whomever or howsoever all the above chattels and effects to
said John J. Coyle deceased and shall and lawfully
be made a true and perfect inventory of all such estate
and the same being so provided do send up inventories
and effects with the inventory of account unto the legal and
proper administration on or before the first Monday in March
next to come thereafter as the ordinary shall direct with all
his orders and doing them and faithfully perform the
trust reposed in him then this obligation to be void otherwise
to remain in full force in Law
