in office in the just and full sum of three thousand Dollars for the pay-
ment of which sum to the said Justices and their successors we bind
our heirs our heirs executors and administrators in the whole and for the
whole sum jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our
seals and dated this Twelfth day of March Eighteen Hundred and forty nine

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the
above bound John Maroney administrator with the will annexed of the goods
chattels and credits of Martha Sitman deceased do make or cause to be
made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods
chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come
to the hands or possession or knowledge of the said John Maroney
or into the possession of any other person or persons for him and the
same do make as submitted to the Court of Ordinary for said County
at such time as he shall be therunto required by said Court of
Ordinary and the same goods chattels and credits do well and truly
administer according to Law and make a just and true account of
all his dealings or actings and dealings by law required and further
do well and truly pay and deliver all the legacies contained and
specified in the said Will as far as the said goods chattels
and credits will extend or the Law requires that this obligation to be
void also remains in full force
