The condition of the above Bond or obligation is such that whereas the said Joseph Straup has been this day appointed Guardian to William H. Johnston orphan of William J. Johnston now if the said Joseph Straup do well and truly demean himself as guardian as aforesaid agreeably to letters of guardianship bearing even date herewith and agreeable to law in such cases made and provided the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
