chattels, and credits of Marilda Jones, late of this County,
deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and
singular, The goods, chattels and credits, both real and person-
al, of The said deceased, which have or shall come to The
hands, possession or knowledge of The said Joseph L Jones,
or into The hands or possession of any other person or persons
for him; and The same so made, do exhibit to The court of
Ordinary of said County, when he shall be thereunto required;
and such goods, chattels, and credits do well and truly admin-
ister according to law, and do make a just and true account of
his actings and doings thereon, when required by The Superior Court,
or Ordinary of said County, and all The rest of The goods, chattels,
and credits, both real and personal, which shall be found
remaining upon the account of The said administration, The
same being first allowed by The court of Ordinary of said coun-
ty, shall deliver and pay to such persons, respectively,
as are entitled to The same by law, and if it shall
hereafter appear that ~~is~~ last will and testament was
