Roberts are held and firmly bound into the honorable Justices of
the Superior Court Sitting as a court of ordinary for said county
their Successors in office in the Just and full sum of Three thousand
Dollars for the true payment of which sum to the said Justices
as aforesaid and their Successors in office we bind our selves our
heirs executors and administrators jointly severally firmly by these
presents Seals with our seals and date this third November
1851.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above
bound John M. Delany has been appointed administrator of the estate both
real and personal of James Madison state of said county deceased
do make a true and perfect inventory of all the estate both
real and personal of said deceased which have or shall come to the
hands possession or knowledge of the said John M. Delany or into
the hands possession of any other person or persons for him or
the same do exhibit into the said court of ordinary
when he shall be thereto required, and such estate do well
and truly account according to law and do make a just
and true account of his doings and doings therein
when the said John M. Delany shall be thereto required by
the Court of ordinary for said county and all the rest of
said estate which shall be found remaining on the account
of the said administration the same being first allowed by
the court shall deliver and pay to such person or persons as
respectfully as are entitled to the same by law and if it
shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament
was made by the deceased and the same be proved before the
court and the executors obtain certificate of the probate
thereof and the said Delany do in such case if required
under and deliver up the said letters of administration to the
