in office in the sum and full sum of Seven
Hundred Dollars for the true payment of which
sum to the said Justices of the Supreme court
sitting as a court of ordinary and their suc-
cessors in office we bind our selves our heirs
executors and administrators jointly severally and
by these presents sealed with our seals and
dated this 3 November 1857.

The condition of the
above obligation is such, that whereas J^m Car-
michael has been appointed Guardian for
Martha Bagnall Wills Administrators Bonds Guardianships 1848/1854
and Mary Bagnall Orphans of Walter Bagnall late
of said County deceased

Now if the said J^m Carmichael
do well and truly demean himself as Guardian
as aforesaid as aforesaid and agreeable to letters
of Guardianship bearing date hereunto
and agreeable to laws in such case made &
provided then this obligation to be void else to
remain in full force and virtue
