such that if the above bound Mary Manning Administratrix of the goods, Chattels &
Credits of Andrew McCallum late of said County deceased, do make a True
and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the
said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or Knowledge
of the said Mary Manning or into the hands or possession of any other person or
persons for her, and the same do exhibit into the said Court of ordinary
when she shall be therunto required, and such goods, Chattels & Credits do
well and truly administer according to law, and make a just and true
account of her acting and doing therein when required by the Inferior Court or
