I Allan, Chose, of Athens Clarke County in Said State, being of Sound and disposing mind and memory do make, Ordain and publish this as my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

I will devise and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Chose, the following property to wit - Fifty Shares in the Stock of the Pioneer Paper Manufacturing Company. Ten Shares in the National Bank of Athens, Three Thousand dollars in bonds of the East Tennessee and Georgia Rail Road, One Thousand dollars in bonds of the Pensacola and Georgia Rail Road and all the bonds owned by me in the Mississippi Central Rail Road Company being between three and four thousand dollars.

I also give and bequeath to my said wife whatever portion of my household furniture she may desire and select for her use and comfort. To have and to hold the foregoing property in her own right without release or limitation, to her and her heirs and their own proper use benefit and behoof forever.

It is further my will that my said wife shall have and enjoy the use and profits of my family residence in Athens, for at least one year after my death together with sufficient money out of my estate for her comfortable support for that time.

The provision made for my wife in the foregoing bequests shall constitute her entire interest in my estate and is in lieu of her whole right of dower.

I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Mrs. Solli, E. Pettillo wife of the Rev William, P. Pettillo of Atlanta, Georgia, all the remainder of my estate both real and personal of whatever kind and wherever situated, including the house and lot of my residence in Athens with all its appurtenances (except as hereinbefore provided) to have and to hold the same to her and her heirs and to their own proper use benefit & behoof forever.

I desire that my Executors shall as soon as practicable reduce to possession whatever may be due to me from persons other than those specified in the bequest to my wife, and apply as sufficient of the same to the payment of any demands against me.

It is my will that after probate of this my will and testament my Executors shall be relieved from making any inventories or Appraisement of my estate, or exposing any part of the same to public sale or making any returns to the Auditors of the County, after admitting this will to probate.

I hereby nominate and appoint my son in law Rev William, P. Pettillo Executor and my wife Mrs. Elizabeth Chose, Executor of this my last will and Testament.
