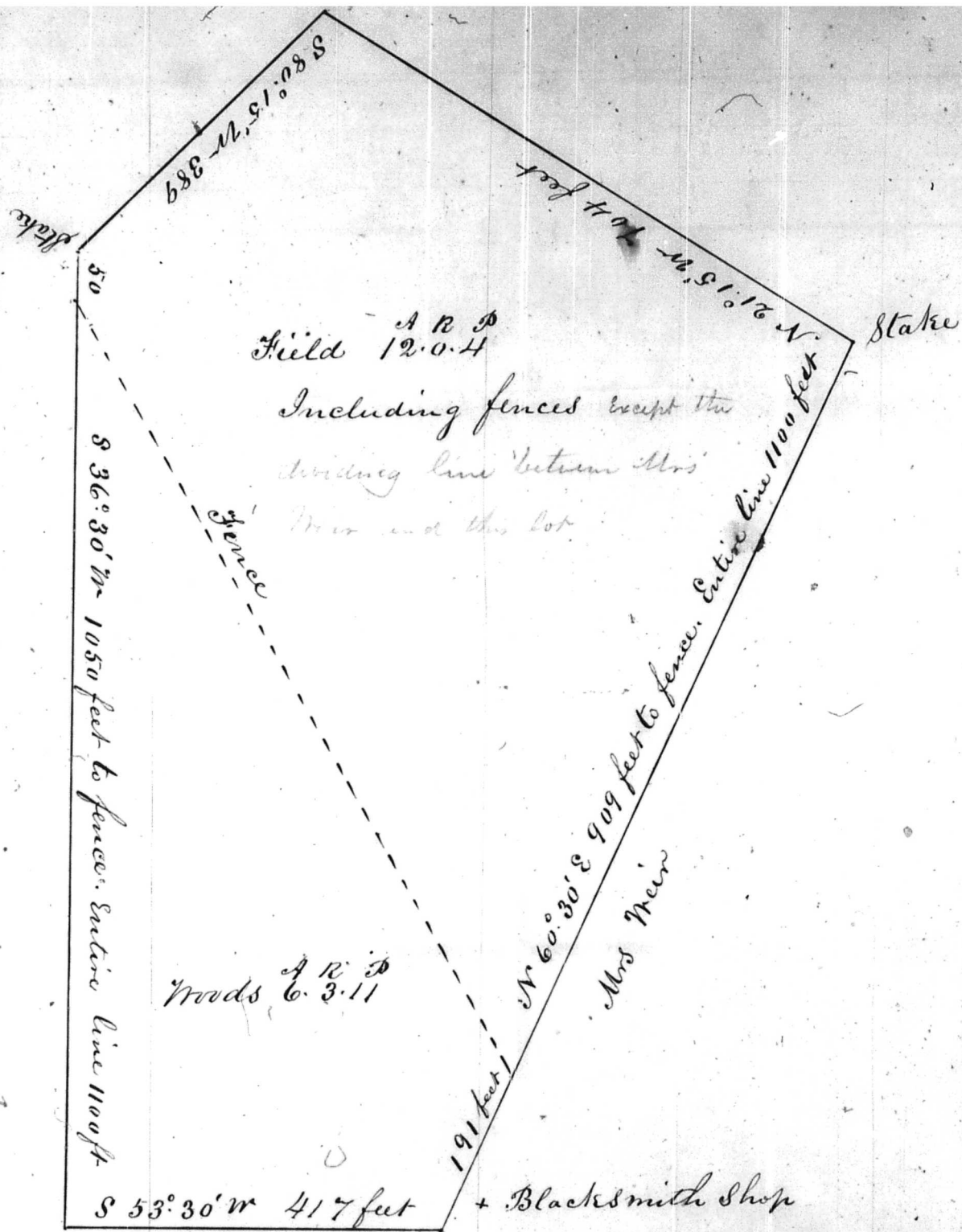
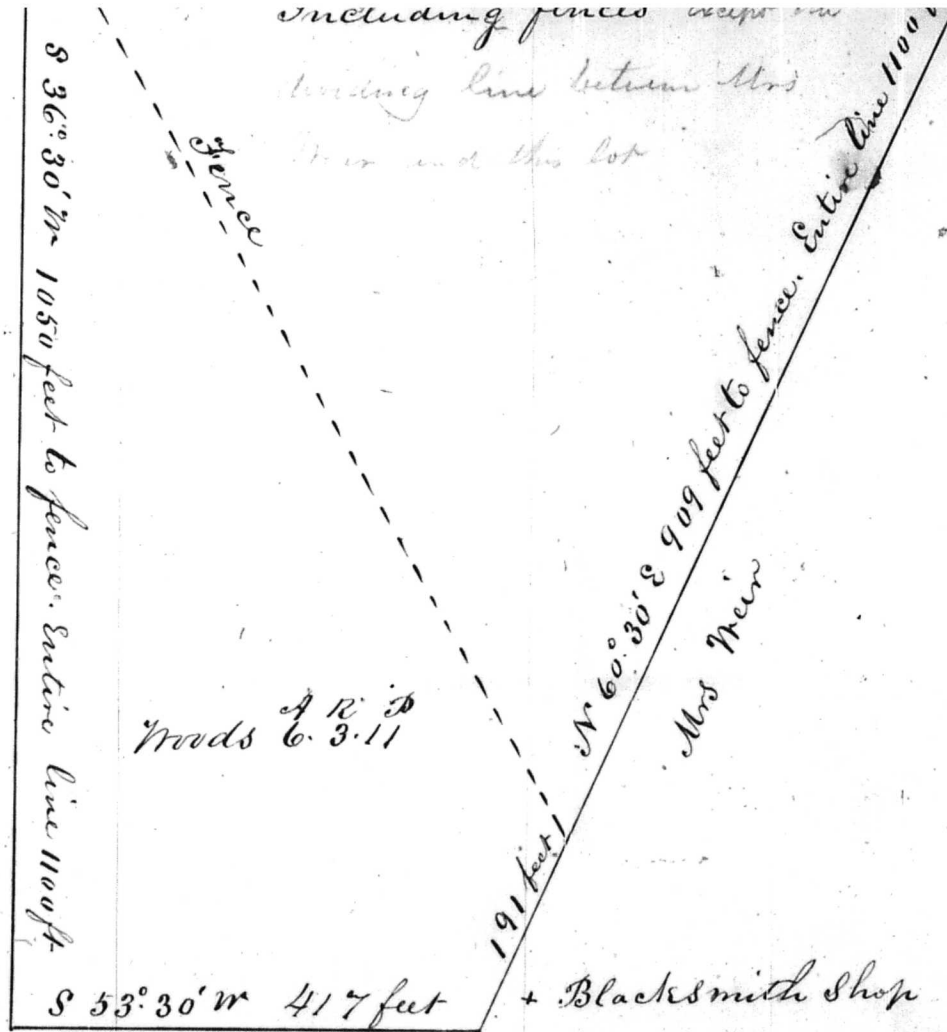




Road from Athens to Jefferson
