Georgia I, Henry M. Delaney of the County of Athens, do hereby make and publish this as my last Will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all others previously made by me.

Item 1st I desire all my just debts to be paid.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto Mrs. Jeremia White, wife of William H. White, two lots containing front over the two Acre more or less, situated at the corner of Spring and Poplar Streets, adjoining lots of Mrs. Martha Whitman and W. H. White known as lots Number Eleven in the Town of Athens the premises now occupied by Emily Reese. To be the property of Mrs. Jeremia White her heirs and assigns forever in fee simple.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to Burrill Shaw person of color for life. And at his death to his heirs. One lot in the Town of Athens and County of Clarke known in the plan of the Town of Athens as the North West fraction of lot Number thirty five according to the Map with the survey lying by and adjoining the lot now occupied by Mrs. John Reynolds, said lot or fraction of a lot containing three quarters of an Acre more or less now occupied by a person of color known as John Russell.

Item 4th It is to be expressly understood that the disposition of my property herein before made is to take effect only in the event of and at my death.

Item 5th If by my will and desire that Mrs. Jeremia White pay two thirds of the amount of my indebtedness and the proceeds of my Estate, and that Burrill shall pay the remaining one third of said indebtedness.

Item 6th I hereby appoint Robert L. Bloomfield my Executor to carry out this will; and direct that he have control and management of the property given in Items two and three to Mrs. White and Burrill Shaw until all of my debts, funeral expenses and expenses are paid. And that if necessary he rent said property and apply the proceeds to this purpose.
