Item 4<sup>th</sup> I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said son Albert H Edwards Executor of this my last Will and Testament,

In Testimony Whereof I said Henry L Edwards have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of May, Eighteen hundred and eighty-two 1882.
