I give bequeath devise and will to my beloved wife Rachel Nester all my Estate both real and personal of every kind and description to have and to hold the same to the proper use benefit and behoof of her the said Rachel Nester her heirs and assigns forever in fee simple hereby vesting the title of my whole Estate in her the said Rachel Nester as fully and as absolutely as the same is now vested in me. I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife Rachel Nester sole Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby making all other wills heretofore by me made.
