their Just Rights as there is no necessity for
Delay

3 Item

I give the great house Dwelled by My beloved
wife Isabella with whom I have lived in
the most quiet Sol of Land where now I
now Reside containing one hundred and
nine Acres with all the Right men and
appurtenances in any manner appertaining
to her or for her use During her natural
Life I also give and bequeath in the same
manner the farming utensils and
belonging to said plantation of every Dis-
cription Horses, Cows, Hogs, Sheep, Oxen,
Cant household, Kitchen furniture &c &c long
as she remains my Widow But if she marry
again Joseph My son is to have one third
at the age of twenty one

Item 4th

My Residence of My property both Real and
personal whatever and whatevr it May be
including that given to my Wife Isabella
During natural Life I give and bequeath
to my son Joseph I hereby constitute and
appoint Minors Executors I Isabella
Executrix of this My Last Will and Testament
This Oct 2. 1873
