I will and bequeath to my beloved

 both real and personal, that I now do
 possess, I upon the conditions following
 viz That Joel A. Billups, Henry C. Bil-
 lups, and John Billups, in consideration
 of what I have already given them shall
 receive fifteen hundred dollars each, less
 than Anna P. Hendgins and Susan Holmes
 Taylor. The distributive shares to which
 Anna P. Hendgins and Susan Holmes
 Taylor are entitled I hereby give and
 bequeath to my son Joel A. Billups in
 trust for the benefit of the said Anna P.
 Hendgins and Susan Holmes Taylor.
 Neither or both of the said Anna P.
 Hendgins or Susan Holmes Taylor shall
 depart this life without a child or
 children then, viz that, event I desire that
 their portions or portions of my estate shall
 never to my surviving children. Whoever
 will and desires that my son Joel A. Billups
 shall judge and deem it for their best in-
 terests that I give him in trust the dis-
 tributive shares of my estate to which all
 my children shall be entitled. I desire
 he will be controlled in this delicate and
 responsible duty by a sound and judicious
 discretion, having an eye single to the best
 interests of his Mother, and being influenced
 by his knowledge of their characters, dispo-
 sitions and habits. I enjoin upon Joel
 A. Billups to pay or settle with my
 surviving estate with money
