Testament,

Item 1st I Commend my soul to God who gave it, and my body to my
family and friends to be buried in a plain and decent
manner.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my Grand son William D
Chancey the son of my Daughter Ann; intending it heres as
a home for my said Daughter Eight Acres more or less of my
Land in the East Corner thereof beginning at a Red Oak
Corner, thence on Hann's line to the branch, thence down to the
Spring, thence on Epps line to a Red Oak, thence to the
beginning and including the Spring

Item 3rd I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife all the balance
of my lands, and the whole of my Estate of Every description
except as hereafter excepted during her natural life, but with
the proviso that my two Daughters Elizabeth and Alley as
long as they remain single shall have a home with her

Item 4th At the death of my Wife I give and bequeath to my
son John all my Land bequeathed to her

Item 5th I Give and bequeath unto my son Calvin five Dollars &c.

Item 6th At the death of my Wife it is my Will and desire that
my three Daughters if living, or the heirs of their bodies, if they
are dead, shall have all the balance of my Estate not herein
bequeathed equally divided among them.

Item 7th I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Richard
Chancey, Executor to this my last Will and Testament
