- Item 4th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Estaline McLean for equal share of the Remainder of my Estate not herein otherwise disposed of.
- Item 5th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Paragula L. L. L. an equal share of the Remainder of my Estate not herein otherwise disposed of.
- Item 6th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Sarah W. L. an equal share of the Remainder of my Estate not herein otherwise disposed of.
- Item 7th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Martha M. L. an equal share of the Remainder of my Estate not herein otherwise disposed of.
- Item 8th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Margaret M. L. an equal share of the Remainder of my Estate and also I give and bequeath unto the said Paragula L. L. L. the sum of \$800 in Dollars in Money and two (2) beds and bedsteads.
- Item 9th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my daughter, Annaline L. L. L. an equal share of the Remainder of my Estate not herein otherwise disposed of.
- Item 10th It is my Will and desire that all my Estate should remain together and be undivided and under the full Control of my Wife, Mrs. Dambrough during her natural life.
- Item 11th I do Truly give and bequeath unto my son-in-law, Samuel D. Hardgrave my Violin.
- Item 12th I do Truly make it my Will and desire that after the death of my Wife that my son-in-law, Samuel D. Hardgrave and his wife, Margaret L. L. L. have and occupy the House and Land upon which is now occupied by me Tinsley J. Dambrough and should have a sufficient
