 publish this my last will & testament in and to
 my lawful heirs and assigns my body being
 first having been first examined and found to be
 of sound mind and memory and being a Christian
 I believe in the resurrection of the body at the last
 day

Item 1st I give bequeath & devise to my said children Julia
 Elizabeth & Frank Margaret Mary & all my lawfully
 born & living kindred who are alive to be
 and their heirs forever in fee simple and in whole
 the house & lot where we now reside and which was
 conveyed to me by their father my husband John
 Thomas Crawford my wish being that my children
 take the same & remain together in it till they are married
 & located and that same descent lady and family be
 allowed to live with them if it can be so arranged
 their means

Item 2nd I hereby appoint my Executor to this my last will &
 testament the testimony given in and to my
 said children & should any of my said children be
 in their minority having no child then my wish
 is that the share of said child & dying shall go to
 & belong to the surviving child or children & should they
 all be children & be to their heirs unless it be
 by will which each of them & family and want to
 make no more arising at the age which comes in when
 parents make a will

Item 3rd I nominate and appoint my said last will & testament
 of this my last will & testament I earnestly request him
 to accept the trust the most sacred that a mother can
 place in the hands of the nation and respectability of the
 children upon the cheerfully consents to him their
 heavenly Father
