I give & bequeath all my Estate both personal & real to my children in the following manner, Viz. To my Daughter Eliza A. Lee my Servant Eliza about 10 years of age & four Ala. & Fla. R. R. Bonds of 500 Dollars each Nos 401, 406, 417 1200 & One New Orleans & Jackson & Savannah Southern R. R. Co Bond One Thousand Dollars No. 1627 & One Pine Bluff & Dallas Road Augusta & Waynesboro R. R. Bonds No 617 to be held in trust for use & support during his natural life the interest only to be used for the service of the servant.

I give to my Son William L. Church my Servant Alfred & four Ala. & Fla. R. R. Bonds of five hundred Dollars each Nos 409, 415, 516 & 518 & two Savannah City Bonds five hundred Dollars each Nos 839 & 840 & One New Orleans & Jackson & Savannah Southern R. R. Bond No 29 to be held in trust for use & support until he becomes twenty one year of age the interest & use of the same to be used.

I give to my Daughter Anna P. Whitner my servant Louisa & one One Thousand Dollar New Orleans & Jackson & Savannah Southern R. R. Bond No. 1130.

I give to my Son M. W. Church twenty one shares in the Ala. & Fla. Banking Co. standing in my name in their Books.

I give to my Son John R. Church one Ala. & Fla. R. R. Bonds Nos 357 & 373 five hundred each & two Augusta & Waynesboro R. R. Bonds Nos 115 & 116.

I give to my daughter Julia C. Quinn two Ala. & Fla. R. R. Bonds 565 & 590 each five hundred Dollars & two Augusta & Savannah R. R. Bonds Nos 436 & 454 five hundred Dollars & fifteen Shares of the S. W. Western R. R. Co.

I give to my daughter Elizabeth C. Relf ten Shares of the S. W. Western R. R. Co. One Thousand Dollars to be paid out of the sale of my farm in Clark Co. Ga.

I give the remainder of the Price of my farm to be divided equally among my children after paying all my lawful debts.

And I give my Servants William & Catherine to my Children to be taken care of & to be removed from them without their consent & concern and also the same with respect to the Servant Sophia & her Children.

And the rest of my Estate whatever it may be to be sold & equally divided among my children.
