I, Mary Porter of the County and State
 aforesaid being men of sound mind and knowing that before my
 long I must go hence and so here no more desire to make a
 disposition of what property a kind providence has bestowed upon me
 I do therefore make & publish this to be my last Will and
 Testament hereby revoking all others by me at any time heretofore
 made.

First

It is my Will and desire that when I die my body may be
 buried in the old Cemetery at Athens near by my dear departed
 Children, and that a well but not costly monument be erected by
 my Executor over my grave. I will also that they, that where will
 and my Children shall repose be inclosed with heavy rock foundation
 and Iron railing.

Second

I Will and desire that my Executor shall as soon after my
 decease as practicable, reduce whatever is due to me to Cash
 and that my debts and burial expenses be paid.

Third

I will and bequeath to the American Bible Society formed in
 New York in the year 1816 the sum of Fifty Dollars to be applied
 to the Charitable use and purposes of said Society. The same
 to be paid by my Executor to any proper Officer or Agent
 of said Society.

Fourth

I will and bequeath to the Missionary Society of the
 Methodist Episcopal Church, South, Fifty Dollars to be paid by my
 Executor to any proper Agent or Officer of said Society.

Fifth

I will and bequeath to my dear friend and relation Mrs
 Corbitt C. Hagnon of Green County my Wardrobe Bed and
 Bedsteads my Bureau and any other articles of room furniture
 that I may own at my death.

Sixth

I will that the residue of my Estate real & personal whatever
 it may be shall be paid & delivered by my Executor to my dear
 brother Albert Gallatin Beckham now living in the State of
 Alabama as I suppose and near Goldville or Bluff Spring.
 If my said brother shall not be in life at my decease then
 it is my will that the bequest contained in this sixth item
 of my will go to his lawful heirs to him & them forever.

Seventh & Last

I hereby constitute & appoint my kind and truly friend
 James W. Carllow of Athens and in case of his death James
 A. Carllow sole Executor of this my Last Will and
 Testament.
