divided, as follows:

I give to my daughter Sarah Sherer five
dollars, to the children of my son Austin
Preswood Deceased the sum of five dollars,
and to the children of my son Joseph B.
Preswood Deceased the sum of five dollars
and to the children of my son Thomas A.
Preswood Deceased the sum of five dollars
and all the rest of my estate real and
personal, I give bequeath and devise to my
two daughters Martha H. Clowers and
Francis Caroline Emerick to be equally
divided between them share and share
alike, and under no circumstances to be
subject to the debts or contracts of their
present or any future husbands, but to be
held in trust by my executors Dr James Compton
for their sole and separate use, with power
to sell any part of part of public or private
sale and make good and sufficient title
thereto to the purchaser.

I nominate and appoint Dr James S.
Compton executors of this my last Will and
Testament, and request him to accept
Grateful for the services he has rendered
me heretofore.
