in a weak and feeble state of health
do make and publish this as my last Will
and Testament, as follows:-

Item 1st

I commit my body to the dust out of which
it is framed, and my soul to the redem-
ption purchased by Christ, and after the
payment of my just debts I devise what
estate it has pleased God to give me to be
divided, as follows:-

Item 2^d

I give to my daughter Sarah Sherin five
dollars, to the children of my son Austin
Preswood deceased the sum of five dollars,
and to the children of my son Joseph B.
Preswood deceased the sum of five dollars
and to the children of my son Thomas A.
Preswood deceased the sum of five dollars
and all the rest of my estate real and
personal, I give legath and devise to my
two daughters Martha W. Clower and
Francis Caroline Emmerken to be equally
divided between them share and share
alikes and under no circumstances to be
subject to the debts or contracts of their
present or any future husbands, not to be
held in trust by my executor Dr. James Comack
for their sole and separate use, with power
to sell any of part of the whole or divide
sale and make good and sufficient titles
thereto to the purchasers.

Item 3rd

I nominate and appoint Dr. James
Comack executor of this my last Will and
Testament, and request him to accept
Grateful for the services he has rendered
me heretofore.
