

Georgia. I Paulina P. Davis of said County and
 Clarke County, State, make, publish and declare this
 to be my last Will and Testament.

First. I give and bequeath the One half of my Estate of every
 kind, real and personal to my Eldest Son, George H.
 Davis, provided the same estate in which I have a
 half interest in my Estate hereby given him is to be disposed
 of as hereinafter directed.

Second. I direct that out of the remaining half of my Estate
 the sum of One Thousand Dollars shall be given to
 my Son, Sampson H. Davis, and that the remaining
 said half of my Estate be divided equally between
 my Daughters, Eliza Davis and my Daughter, Hannah H. Wallace.

Third. In the event of the marriage of my daughter, Eliza
 H. Davis, I direct that she shall first receive out of the
 half of my Estate given her absolutely provided she
 is unmarried, an interest equal in amount to the
 interest given in the foregoing section to each of my
 children, George H. Davis and Hannah H. Wallace, and
 that the remainder of said half interest, shall be
 equally divided between my said daughter, Eliza H.
 Davis and my other children, George H. Wallace, George H.
 Davis and Sampson H. Davis, or the representatives of
 such as may be deceased.

Fourth. I direct that the property which my said daughter,
 Hannah H. wife of Geo. H. Wallace, may take under this
 Will shall be held in trust for the sole use, benefit
 and advantage of herself and child or children,
 absolutely free from the Credit, debts, demands and liabilities
 of her Husband in any manner whatever, during the
 natural life of my said daughter, Hannah H. and if she
 dies leaving a child or children, then the said Estate to
 be held and managed by said trustee for the use and
 benefit of said child or children, and if my said
 daughter, Hannah H. shall die leaving no child then
 it is my Will that at her death the said Estate, hereby left
 to her use, shall rest in my surviving child or children
 or their legal representatives, and I hereby
 appoint my Son, Sampson H. Davis trustee for the
 property given my said daughter, Hannah H. and
 in the event of the death or disability of my Son,
 Sampson H. I appoint my Son, George H. Davis as
 trustee in his stead.

Fifth. I hereby nominate and appoint, my Brother
 James Thomas, Executor of this my last Will
 and Testament, with the request that he will
 take charge of, collect and manage in the
 manner he may desire, but the Estate herein
 bequeathed to my said daughter, Eliza H. Davis
 so long as she remains unmarried,
