and Testament hereby (containing and concur-

1. I desire and direct that my body be  
buried in a decent and Christian like manner,  
suitable to my circumstances and condition  
My soul I trust shall return to God with  
God who gave it as I hope for eternal  
salvation through the blessed Saviour  
Jesus Christ.
2. I desire and direct that all my just debts  
be paid without delay by my executors herein  
also named as I am unwilling my creditors  
should be delayed of their rights.
3. I desire or give to daughters Matilda East  
and Elizabeth East all of said Land or  
Parcel of Land in the State and County  
aforesaid lying on the South Side of the  
Hog Mountain Head beginning with  
W A Sherman's line or boundary extending the  
said land thus running with the said  
land to William Jackson's line on said  
land, said parcel of land adja-  
cency Sherman's pasture, at the place  
where George W M Whitehead & W A  
Sherman's lands, with all the rights  
members and appurtenances to said lot  
of land in any way appertaining and  
belonging thereto.
4. I desire or give to my son Davis D East  
and my daughter Ann Wood all of  
that Parcel of Land in the State  
and County aforesaid lying on the North  
Side of the Hog Mountain Head beginning  
where W A Sherman's line intersects the  
said land running with the said land  
to a line William Jackson's line intersecting  
the said land, adjoining Sherman's pasture  
Land for Whitehead the said of G W  
Clinton, children of W A Sherman with all  
the rights members and appurtenances to said  
lot of land in any way appertaining and  
belonging thereto.

5<sup>th</sup> I give or bequeath to my Daughter Matilda East and Elizabeth East all my cattle consisting of one Stot, two Milk Cows, two yearlings, also two Tugs, one Waggon and the tools, the Skill of Slaves, Blacksmith tools Crooking Utensils, Corn, Groceries, Wheat, Meal and any other article that may belong to the place.

6<sup>th</sup> my Estate and Appurtenances I give to my wife A. Thompson Extantable this day last Will and Testament this January 31<sup>st</sup> 1868 — *Pelas X East* — *J. S. Jackson*
