Item 1st Having by an Instrument duly attested and recorded made & signed as died to my beloved wife Julia I bequeathed to the house & block in which she now resides for her own use & the heirs of her body by me.

Item 2nd I do hereby ratify and confirm the same. I have also subscribed for her share (the wife of my friend deceased) was for Ten Shares (10) of the Capital Stock of the Athens Building and Loan Association. I hereby confirm the same & further devise that the monthly instalments for the said stock shall be paid out of my estate until such Association shall determine to close.

Item 3rd I furthermore ordain and devise that in consideration of the faithful services and good will I bear to my friend, I have a block now known as Black Crawford & Co. shall be paid the sum of One hundred Dollars out of my estate.

Item 4th I furthermore ordain and devise that all business whatsoever that I have as a partner of Jonathan Hampton & now known as the firm of Hampton Crawford shall be closed as early as practicable consistent with the interests of said business.

Item 5th I furthermore ordain & devise that all of my honest debts be paid after which all of my estate both real and personal I do by this presents give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Julia Crawford and our 3 children Susan Elizabeth, William Hugh and Mary Lou Crawford Thorne and should also and I do hereby appoint and constitute my wife aforesaid testamentary Guardian of said children as hereinafter.

Item 6th As to the execution and carrying out of the provisions of the foregoing will and testament I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Julia Crawford executrix of the same & by these presents appoint and associate with her my friend Doct. Mc Smith to advise with and assist in carrying out the provisions of this my last will and testament.
