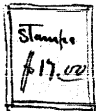

& Lamb One bed Bedstead & furniture besides notes
on him also for advances My daughter Martha has received
only one negro girl Ann One bed and furniture having
been made by herself she is not to account for it

At the death of my wife, after my demise, or if it should
outlive her at my death it is my will and desire that the
whole of my estate be divided between my son John Wade
My daughter Matilda Hanson and my daughter Martha
Martha divide each one to account for what they have
already received so that each may be equal at the close of
the division of my Estate and if Matilda Hanson should
be dead at the happening of the above events then her
children to come in and occupy the position she would if
living by drawing her share

I wish no appointment of my estate as follows, or in
any way during the life of my wife but the appoint-
ment to be made when she dies if she survives me
