Lost Will of William P. White of said
County and State.

- Item 1st Intending this will to be a final disposition
of my estate I hereby revoke all wills heretofore
made by me -
- Item 2nd I wish my executrix as soon as may be after my
death to pay my just debts, and desire that
she shall select from the property left by me
that which can best be used for this purpose according
her humbler to retain my last place with and at length
to purchase of John P. P. Cobb the building he has
erected thereon as per the terms of our contract -
I empower her at any time to sell any portion of my
estate publicly or privately as she may think best for the
interest or increase of the same.
- Item 3rd It is my wish that my executrix should if practicable (but this I
leave to her option) so agree with my nephew John P.
White that the book selling business hitherto carried on
by me shall be continued under his charge, she furnishing
the requisite capital from my estate, and he conducting
the business, advising her fully at all times of its condition
and consulting her in matters of deposit. The profits and
losses of the same to be shared between them.
- Item 4th I will to my wife Rebecca B. White all my property -
during her life time to have the use and enjoyment of
the same, providing therefrom for my children either off
and jointly with for their minor and coming of age
equally therefrom as the children become of age or
marry, such portion as she may think best, and at her
death the same or whatever may remain of the same after
all the children are made equal with each other in what
may have been given off from the property given in this
Will to be equally divided among the children that
survive her and for their sole and separate use, and
the issue of any deceased child - it to stand in the place
of the parent. Should no issue of mine survive us
then at her death, one half of the estate my wife can dispose
of by will as it may go to that of her children that are now
of age to her, and the other half shall be distributed
among the children of my sons, brothers and sisters, each
nephew, and niece to receive an equal portion of the same
for their sole and separate use.
- Item 5th I do hereby appoint my wife the said Rebecca B. White
the executrix to this my will.
