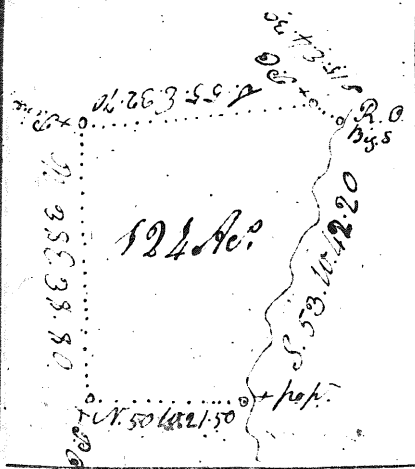

 presents doth Grant bargain sell unto the said Ed-
 ward Hagans all that tract or parcel of Land
 containing one hundred and twenty four acres part
 of a survey Originally granted to Harbory situated
 on the waters of Barber Creek bounded as followeth
