Ordered, that the Clerk grant letters of Administration to Thomas Willoughby on the estate of Elijah Willoughby dec^d out of term time - Giving bond & security in form of the law in the sum of one thousand Dollars -

Letters of Administration on the estate of Elijah Willoughby dec^d was granted to Thomas Willoughby in pursuance of an order passed at the last term, who was duly qualified and gave David Willoughby for security -
5th Novr 1832 -
