 I Elizabeth Junner considering the uncertainty
 of this mortal life and being of sound mind and
 memory do make this my last will and Testament
 in manner and form following (that is to say)
 First I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty
 God that gave it and my body to be buried in a
 decent and Christian like manner second I
 give and bequeath to my eldest son Jesse Junner
 during his life time a negro man Mack and a
 girl Malinda one half of my stock horse hold
 and kitchen furniture and at his my son Jesse
 Junners death all of this property is to belong to
 my son James Junners Children Third I also
 give and bequeath to my son James Junners Children
 the balance of my Estate to wit a negro man York
 a woman Sylvia Fells Judy Charles and Linn and
 also one half of my stock Horse hold and kitchen
 furniture and whatever may complete my Estate Lastly
 I appoint my Brother Matthew Marable sole executor
 of this my last Will and Testament I witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal the fifth day of
 August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and forty five
