and Conveyed and doth by these presents grant bargain sell and convey  
unto the said William Mathews his heirs and Assigns all that tract or parcel  
of land situated lying and being in the County of Clark and State aforesaid  
Containing Two hundred and fourtenth and fourtenth acres to the said  
more or less. Monthly, and in quarters acres due to said John F. Gentry  
by William Callaway (d.) bearing date the tenth day of January  
One thousand Eight hundred and thirty six having the following
