I Humphrey Pittard of the State and
County above mentioned, Recurring that it
was appointed unto, and to do, do make
this my last Will and Testament,

- 1 First I Reigim my soul to God who gived
it and may long be he buried in Christian
like manner,
- 2 Second Of the goods and Chattels which
god has pleased to bless me with
It is my Will that my first wife be
first paid
- 3 It is my Will that my wife Sarah
Pittard have and receive give by the name
of Voted extra and that all of the
ballance of my property be kept together
and remain in the hands of my wife
and that my Children be supported and
Educated out of the proceeds of the same
- 4 Fourth It is Will that my Children as
they become of lawful age have and receive
such as my Wife may think best to give
of to them to be taken at maturities,
- 5 Fifth It is my Will that if my Wife
shall have another Child within mine
months after my death then it shall be
as lawful heir and equal with my other
Children ^{in the} division of my estate,
- 6 Sixth It is my Will that my Executors
sell at private or public sale as may
be thought best three Lots of Land to
wiz One in Somerset County and two
others in the Sherburne County the proceeds
to be used a part of my Estate and used
if necessary for the support and education
of my children,
- 7 Seventh It is my Will that if my Wife
shall ever marry then that my
estate be equally divided among my wife

and Children, and that if my Children have
 as they should among themselves shall have each
 had his or her proper share, as my Wife may think
 best, and I am bound to give of to them nothing
 all equal,

8. It is my Will that my dear Wife have
 power to give of or dispose to a devised at
 any time she may think proper of any
 part or portion of my estate as she may
 think best taking care at all times to
 make all of my of Children equal, or
 at her deaths then my estate to be equally
 divided amongst my children,

Lastly I Ordain and Appoint
 my self beloved Wife my Executor
 to this my Will, then the Fifth day of
 April Eight hundred & forty seven
