convey unto the said Wm. Matthews Sr his heirs and assigns all  
that tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the  
County of Clark and lying in the valley of French Creek and in the  
said tract bounded as following beginning at a white Oak at corner  
joining lands of Wm. Davis his and odd field thence northward  
with said Davis lands Sixty rods to a red Oak at the head of  
Henry Creek so thence northward with said Henry land Eighty rods  
to an oak on the east bank of French Creek thence down  
said Creek with Franklin Davis lands Ninety five rods to a small white  
Oak on the East Bank of Creek aforesaid thence forty rods to  
the beginning corner containing thirty two acres, it being a part of the  
tract of land known as the Sarah King lands on which Isaac  
Weston now resides. To have and to hold said tract or parcel  
of land, unto him the said Wm. Matthews Sr his heirs and assigns  
together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances  
thereof, to the same in any manner belonging to his and their own  
proper uses benefit and behoof forever, and full compleat.

conveyed and doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and  
convey unto the said Wm. Matthews Jr his heirs and assigns all  
that tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the  
County of Clark and lying out the waters of Fourt Creek and with  
such lands bounded as follows, beginning at a white Oak at corner
