Item 2nd I wish my body to be buried in a decent manner.

Item 3rd My desire is that all my just debts be paid.

Item 4th My desire is that my loving wife Polly Daniell have the sole use and occupancy of the house & plantation wherein I now live, during her natural life, with the household and kitchen furniture and plantation tools.

Item 5th I Give to my son George Daniell Senr. my old Cypress Chest.

Item 6th My desire is that all the remainder of my Estate both Real and personal, shall be equally divided, share and share alike between my beloved Wife Polly Daniell, and all my Children herein after named to wit, Rachel Barker, Josiah Daniell, Jeremiah Daniell, Eleanor Brasley, Beata Daniell, Masters Daniell, Alford Daniell, Moseham Daniell, Moses Daniell, Robert Daniell and Olive Hamby, and to my Executor herein after named as Trustees for my Daughter Cary Hodges, the share of my said Daughter Cary to be equal to the share of each of my other Children, and to be held by my executor in trust for her sole use, and benefit, and should any of her share remain at her death, I desire that it be given to my grand daughter Mary Feller.

Item 7th After the death of my beloved wife Polly Daniell, the plantation, houses &c. heretofore and herein bequeathed to her to be divided amongst and between the same Children and in the same manner as pointed
