

Last Will & Testament of James L Ingram

In the name of God amen. I James L. Ingram sr of the County of Clay and State of Georgia being of sound mind & memory and considering the uncertainty frail and transitory life do therefore make ordain publish and declare this to be my last will and testament to say First that after all my just debts are paid discharged the residue of my Estate real and personal give bequeath & dispose of as follows to wit

To my dear Wife Elizabeth Ingram one on Brabham & Hoover for \$986.00. 500 five hundred dollars in cash and bed & bed clothes

To all my children I give bequeath all my personal & Real Estate except to my two girls they to have a horse bridle & Saddle extra and in case James should die his part to go to his children the balance of any residue to them that is now living or their heirs that may be living at my decease equally between them share and share alike Likewise I make constitute and appoint to be my executors of my last will & testament Augustus D Ingram Elder D Ingram James L Ingram & Sarah M Ingram these alike executors and I hereby revoke all wills by me made

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my Seal this 26th Day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four
