

Record of the last will & testament of Leroy T Boyt

Georgia Clay County
We Fleming Foster J R Hardwick Jno H Gilbert were present
Wednesday (22) November eighteen hundred & fifty five (1855) at the
residence of Leroy T Boyt a married man (18) eighteen hours before
his death in possession of his mental faculties he called upon us
to take notice of what he was about to say I appoint John W
Pittman my executor I want my effects to remain together during
my wife's widowhood after wards to be equally distributed I want
a good little home purchased for my wife and children by my
executor. My shop books an a security for the debts for the firm
of Boyt & Dancy I have paid One hundred and sixty dollars
at an other time (60) sixty dollars out of my own private funds
but after the shop debts are settled John Dancy is equally in-
