

Record of the last Will & Testament of Mary Henderson

Georgia In the name of God amen

Cearly County & I Mary Henderson of the said County & State being far advanced in life and knowing that I must soon depart from this to a better world do make and declare this instrument to be my last Will & Testament

First I desire that my body shall be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances & condition.

Second, My soul I resign to God who gave it hoping for salvation in the merits of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose Religion I most I have enjoyed for nearly fifty Years

Third, the house & lot whereon I now reside I give and bequeath to my son Isaiah T Henderson

Fourth I give and bequeath to my two daughters Clementine Galloway & Mary A Johnson the whole of my household and kitchen furniture including tables trunks Spoons side board feather beds & bedsteads with their furniture - Clock and every thing else pertaining to my house

Fifth To my Grand son John B Johnson I give & bequeath my cow & Calf

Sixth To my Grandson John B Johnson I give & bequeath my horse pin hook And I do further more nominate & appoint my esteemed friend John H Jones my executor to this my last Will & Testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixteenth day of April 1853
