 hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made,
 And first I commit my soul to God who gave it & my body I desire
to be buried in a decent & Christianlike manner, and my worldly estate I
dispose of as follows -

First I desire & direct that all my just debts be paid without delay
by my Executor hereafter named & appointed.

Second I hereby give bequeath & desire to my beloved Nephew
Robert E. Holland minor son of John L. Holland & Martha A.
Holland of said state & county all the property of every kind
both real & personal of which I now am possessed in fee
simple & forever and I hereby appoint my trustworth friend
John L. Holland guardian of the property of said minor Robert
E. Holland.

Third I hereby constitute & appoint my friend John L. Holland
of said state & county my Executor of this my last will &
testament

In witness whereof I the said Robert Henderson to this my will have
hereunto set my hand & seal this the Eight day of February Eighteen
Hundred & Sixty Nine (1869) Robert Henderson
