I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Stansworth
wife of W. S. Stansworth and the heirs of her body free and ex-
-empted from all liabilities of her present or any future hus-
-band, the following property to wit: One hundred and forty
four acres of land (144) wherein said Stansworth now lives,
and described as follows, commencing at N. E. Stewart line and
and running along the public road, thence from front corner to the
ough Isa in an easterly direction to such a point that running due
north to J. Evans line will get one hundred and forty four
it being a part of land lot No 1 No 2 & No 15 lying and being in the 6th
Dist of Originally Henry now Clayton County.

Second, I give and bequeath to my son William C. Camp the fol-
-lowing property to wit: One hundred and forty four (144) acres of
land wherein the said W. C. Camp now lives described as follows,
it being the last of land lot No 3, lying and being in the 6th District of
Originally Henry now Clayton County.

Third, I give and bequeath to my son H. C. Camp the following property
to wit: Thirty eight (38) acres of land off of land lot No 15 in
in the 12th District of Originally Henry now Clayton County, described
as follows, said land is adjoining lands of J. Evans.

Fourth, I give and bequeath to my son J. A. Camp the following
property to wit: Two hundred acres (200) of land described as follows,

C. Camp, and running south far enough to obtain one hundred and forty four acres (144) of land, lying in the 6th District of Original Henry now Clayton County.

Sixth I give and bequeath to my son J. W. Camp the following property to wit: One hundred and forty four (144) acres of land, off of the east side of land lot No 32, in the 6th District of Original Henry now Clayton County.

Seventh I give and bequeath to my son Harris C. Camp the following property to wit: One hundred and forty four (144) acres of land, it being the remainder of lot No 32 and not already disposed of, and also the remainder of lot No 15 not already disposed of making in all one hundred and forty four acres more or less, the first mentioned land in the 6th District and the last mentioned parcel in the 12th West of Original Henry now Clayton County.

Eighth I further declare that the remainder of my personal estate be sold and equally divided between all my children after paying expenses of settling up my estate.

Ninth And I further declare that my household furniture be equally between my children.

Tenth And lastly I do nominate and appoint my brother J. W. Camp to be the executor of this my last Will and Testament.
