I Andrew Vanhook of said
State and county knowing the uncertainty of life
and the certainty of Death deem it right and
proper both as respects myself and family that
I should make a disposition of the property a kind
providence has blessed me with
I therefore make this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking and annulling all
others hitherto made by me
Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and christianlike manner suitable
to my circumstances in life my soul I trust
shall return to rest with god who gave it
Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my debts be
paid without delay my executor hereafter
named as I am unwilling my creditors should
be delayed of their rights as there is no necessity
for delay

Item 3rd I give and devise my land and house
of which I am now in possession of to my two
sons (Giles & George) I further bequeath and assign
I further bequeath to my two sons for their benefit
for the purpose of raising and educating them until
they become of age and also all stock and plantation
tools and crop then on after paying the debts of the estate
I think I desire that my son George P. Vanhook remain
a beneficiary of my estate as named in Item third
and be a Christian and of the age of age then to
be placed on an equal footing with my other sons
having a good bed and furniture a cow and

Calf and a year provisions and coming in for an equal share of the remainder of my estate
Item 5th I desire that my son Andrew Schuckersley remain as heretofore of my estate until the turning of 18 years of age then to be placed upon an equal footing with my other heirs having a good bed and furniture a cow and calf and a year provisions and then coming in for an equal share of the remainder of my estate

Item 6th I desire when my son George P. Schuckersley becomes of age the Christmas following his inheritance share third estate and half the proceeds of my effects to go to the maintenance of my son Andrew Schuckersley until Christmas after he is of age

Item 7th I desire that the share of my Grand Children when brothers are dead or may die before the final winding up of my estate to remain in the hands of my executors until they are of age and provided one die the Brothers sister if any to receive its share if no Brothers and Sisters the share to return to my estate and be divided among my heirs

Item 8th I desire that when all the conditions of the foregoing will are completed with these the remains of my estate to be sold and equally divided among my heirs

Item 9th I constitute and appoint my worthy friend Jeremiah M. Hamrick executor to this my last will and Testament and I George P. Schuckersley when he becomes of age July 11th 1877
